

# Whole School Assemblies on Energy Saving 2022 (depending on Covid)



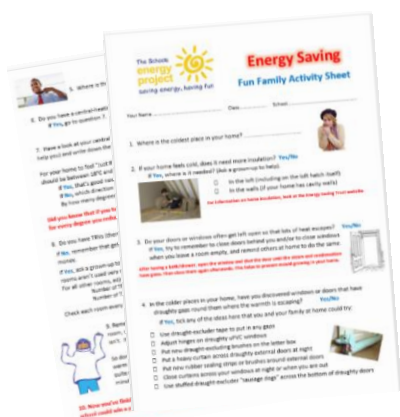

On the day of the assembly, you will be given a batch of thermometer cards, enough for one to be put up in every classroom in your school, to help the children and staff monitor if the school's heating system is too hot, too cold or Just Right!
