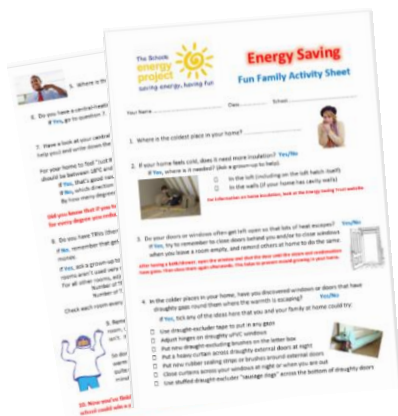
On the day of the assembly, you will be given a batch of thermometer cards, enough for one to be put up in every classroom in your school, to help the children and staff monitor if the school's heating system is too hot, too cold or Just Right! And for schools in the New Forest area, we are able to provide enough thermometer cards so that every child and every member of staff can have one to take home.
